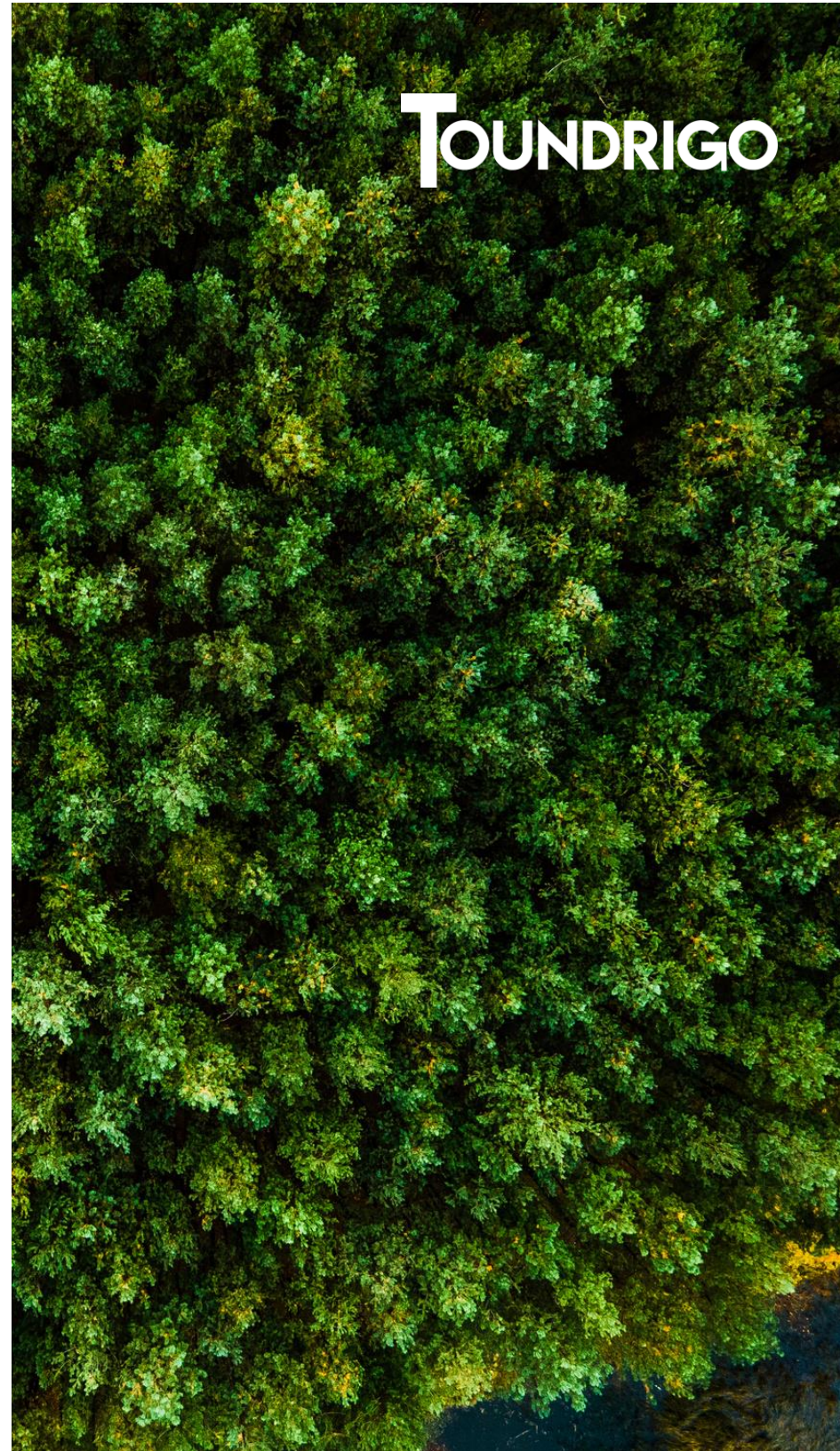




# **Sustainable code of conduct for drivers**

### **RESPONSIBLE ENGINE MANAGEMENT**

- Switch off the engine during long stops to avoid unnecessary fuel consumption and limit pollutant emissions.
- Start the engine only a few minutes before departure to ensure efficient start-up.

### **OPTIMIZED USE OF AIR CONDITIONING**

- Do not operate the air conditioning when the vehicle is stationary without passengers.
- Maintain a reasonable temperature (around 24°C) to avoid excessive energy consumption.
- Use natural ventilation when conditions allow.

### **REDUCING PLASTIC WASTE**

- Avoid the sale of plastic water bottles on buses.
- Encourage the use of reusable water bottles and provide water refilling points where possible.

### **ECO-FRIENDLY DRIVING**

- Drive smoothly and proactively to reduce fuel consumption and vehicle wear.
- Maintain a steady speed and respect speed limits to optimize fuel efficiency.
- Avoid sudden braking and acceleration.

### **AWARENESS AND COLLABORATION**

- Inform and educate passengers on environmentally responsible practices during the trip.
- Collaborate with the team and other transport stakeholders to identify and implement sustainability improvements.

### **REGULAR VEHICLE MAINTENANCE**

- Maintain vehicles regularly to ensure fuel efficiency and limit pollutant emissions.
- Check tire pressure and engine condition to avoid over-consumption.
